Dear Meridian Families,

I just wanted to take a minute to thank everyone in our community for your contribution to what was truly an awesome 22-23 school year! Our theme for this year was to approach the year with "an open heart & open mind." Throughout the year, as a community, we definitely lived up to this mission. One point of pride this year is the way our students responded as we implemented a new, more rigorous literacy curriculum called Benchmark Advanced. I routinely heard students saying things such as, "This is hard, but it's helping me learn" and "CMAS was easy compared to Benchmark." After students and teachers began to unpack it and figure out the routines, I can say that it truly was rigorous, worked to target student individual needs, and we could see students make a ton of growth. We, of course, won't see CMAS scores until the fall, but this conclusion is evident in the growth we have seen as a school on MAP testing from fall to spring. I am proud to say that in the reading portion of the MAP test, all 5 grade levels (1-5) reached their growth projection goal, and in 3 of the 5 grade levels, 75% or more of students reached their growth target. This is truly an accomplishment and is among the best growth scores seen across the entire district!

Beyond the great year we experienced academically, we also saw our kids grow socially, working to create well-rounded citizens of our community. One highlight of the year was being able to honor students every week by highlighting the wide range of "superpowers" that students and staff across our school offer the world. In addition, our students continue to report in high numbers feeling a sense of ownership over their school, feel welcomed and seen, and most of all, feel proud to be a part of something bigger than themselves. Our staff was at the center of our success by making sure every student felt connected to each other and adults, engaged in rigorous discourse with one another, and that students received the feedback at the needed level that creates intrinsic motivation. I would also like to send out a huge cheer to our PTO, who came through, as they always do, to partner with the school to reimagine new ways to reconnect and celebrate while maintaining important traditions. It was so great to gather again for the Mustang Mile, Trunk-or-Treat, hold a Luau Dance, and once again, have a full Field Day.

This time of year is often bittersweet as we say goodbye to our 5th graders, departing staff, and close out the school year. However, it is also an exciting time as we begin to welcome in a new class of kindergartners, have new families moving into our community, and bring new staff members on board to care for our children. As we look forward to the 23-24 school year, Meridian is poised to do even greater things because of the positive trajectory we were set on this year due to the contributions of everyone in partnership for our kids!

I wish everyone the best possible summer and I can't wait to see all the bright shining faces back with us for the first day of school on August 14.
