- Online Check-In
 - All returning families are required to complete the district's <u>online check-in</u> by August 14 through your <u>Infinite Campus Parent Portal</u>.
 - If you do not complete this process by Aug. 5, you will not be able to view your student's teacher assignment in Infinite Campus when it is released.
- School Supply Lists & Technology Devices
 - Available on the <u>Meridian website</u> under Resources.
 - We are excited that we will continue to be a 1 to 1 technology device school in which every student will have their own device checked out to them.
 - Students who ended last year in grades 3-5 will continue to use their district issued device that they had over the summer.
 - Students in grades K-2 will have a device issued to them.
 - It is preferable that students use a district-provided device to ensure they are managed with the most recent updates and all relevant software they need. It is **not** required for families to purchase a device for school use.

 - Teacher assignments can be **viewed in the Infinite Campus Parent Portal beginning August 5** for families that have completed the online check-in process.
 - Our staff has put a lot of thought and consideration into the class lists for the upcoming school year to ensure balanced class make-up and size. **Meridian does not accept teacher change requests.**
