Arrival/dismissal Reminders:

 We understand that during the first week it can be a challenge to learn new systems and routines, especially when it comes to getting all our kids in and out of school safely.
 Thank you for your patience and cooperation this week and in the future!

- Students should arrive at school no earlier than 7:45 (if eating breakfast) or 7:50 (if not eating breakfast. Unfortunately, we are not able to provide outside supervision before 7:45.
- Walkers/Bikes: During the first week, we understand the need for parents to help guide students to the right spot. Now that students have the routines and locations down, we ask that parents allow students to walk up to the doors independently. If ever a student needs help, please send them to someone in a yellow vest outside to help them get to the right place. Walking students should be dropped off at the exit/entrance to the lot on the sidewalk near the signs that say, "Walkers, please drop off students here."
- Driving: In the hug & go lane, please remember to pull forward as far as you can before letting students out, have students exit the passenger side, and all others should remain in the vehicle. Also remember that it is a right turn only exiting the lot. This helps ensure safety as well as efficiency in getting everyone through the line quickly. Remember, if you want to drive, but don't want to use the hug & go, you are welcome to park on the street in the drop off areas and allow students to walk up to their door.
- **Parking:** Please be mindful of the location of no parking signs in the neighborhood and adhere to all posted signs. It can be especially difficult around McKay Park Cr. on the school side of the street near the bus lane. When cars park here, the buses cannot get through or make a turn. Thanks for your attention to this!

Breakfast and Lunch

- Remember that breakfast and lunch are not free this year as we have become

Technology Updates from Mr. Plummer

- We are excited to continue to be a 1-to-1 device school! After the first week, all students in grades 1-5 should now have their chromebook checked out and issued to them.
 Kindergarten students will have them checked out after the 2nd week.
- Students in K-2 will keep devices at school unless their teacher sends them home on occasion. Students in grades 3-5 will take their device home each night and students should be responsible for making sure it is charged and brought with them each day.
- It is highly encouraged that students use their district issued Chromebook for school work. This will ensure that they have access to the most up to date software and security. The district IT department cannot support or troubleshoot issues with personal devices.
